

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
#### 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




#### 2. How well was the faculty prepared for the class?




#### 3. Teaching/communication style of the Faculty




#### 4. The Faculty's approach to teaching can best be described as




#### 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the faculty.




#### 6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




7. The institution takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visits for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in pursuing higher studies and career planning




9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.








#### 11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




### 12. The faculties illustrate the concepts through examples and real life applications.




13. The faculty identifies your strengths and encourages you with providing right level of challenges.






15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/faculty use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.






18. Efforts are made by the institute/ faculty's to inculcate soft skills, certificate courses, life skills, employability skills and Placement Training to make you ready for the world of work




19. What percentage of faculty's uses ICT tools such as LCD projector, Smart Board, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
