Vidhya Sagar Women's College was started in the year 2005 to educate women students and empower them wholesome development. Our college offers 10 Undergraduate and 2 Post graduate courses with the strength of 2000 + students.

We have well-equipped Laboratories, Very unique Language Lab, Excellent Library, Smart Classrooms, a Spacious Auditorium, and Sports facilities including a badminton court, basketball court, and a large playground.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

It's a proud moment of our institution for the achievement of around **600** students graduated in the academic year 2023 - 2024. We are glad to mention that more than 30 students secured centum and achieved 90% percent results in various subjects in the university exams.

Notably, Mrs. T. Vijayalakshmi, faculty from the Department of Computer Science has successfully qualified the UGC NET Exam conducted by NTA.
