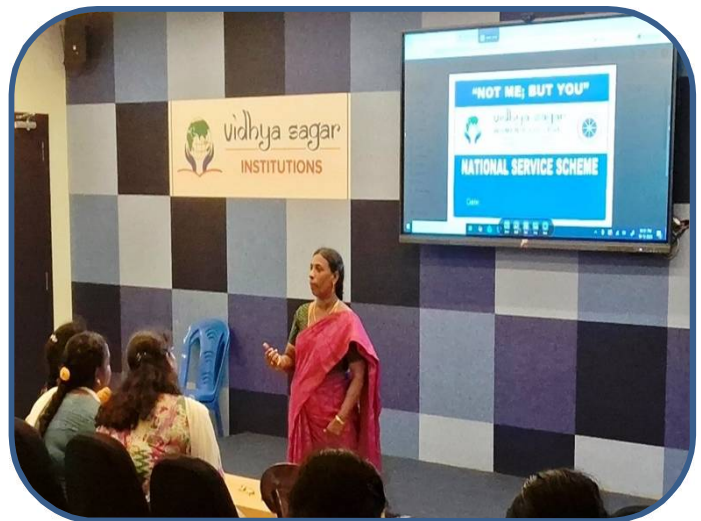

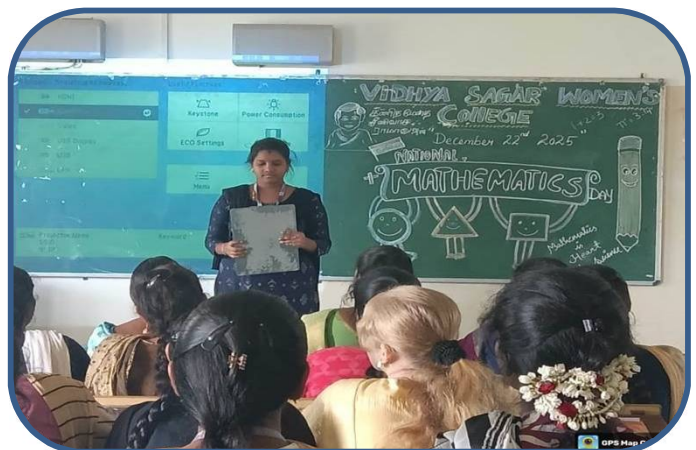

INDUSTRIAL VISIT REPORT

We visited Hatsun Agro Product Limited (HAP), Kanchipuram, on 23rd December 2025 as part of our academic industrial visit. The visit helped us understand how a large dairy organization functions from milk procurement to final distribution. The company staff welcomed us and explained their processes simply and clearly. We were explained about milk procurement, where milk collected from farmers is immediately chilled to around 4°C to preserve freshness. The milk then undergoes pasteurization, during which it is heated to approximately 72°C for a few seconds and rapidly cooled to ensure safety and quality.



It was clearly informed that milk that does not meet quality standards is rejected by the supplier, highlighting the company's strict quality control practices. The staff explained the different types of milk processed, such as full cream milk, toned milk, double toned milk, and standardized milk, which are produced based on fat and nutritional content. We were also taken through various departments, including processing, packaging, storage, and dispatch, where hygiene and safety measures were strictly followed. We learned about HAP's strong distribution and logistics system, through which products reach customers under well-known brands like Arun, Arokyia, Hatsun, HAP Daily, Ibaco, Santosa, Hanobar, Havia, Milky Moo, and Daily Moo. The coordination between departments and the transparent working system showed how consistency and quality are maintained on a large scale. Overall, the visit was informative and gave us a clear understanding of industrial operations and organizational functioning. The management also greeted us with hamper gifts and ice cream, which made the visit pleasant and memorable. The industrial visit helped us connect classroom learning with real-time industry practices.
